



1	Is there any age restriction? No, aspirants with above eligibility irrespective of their age can apply.
2	Are these courses recognised? Yes. As per NEP 2020 only ECCE Courses are being recognized as uniform teaching curriculum (Refer NEP 2020 Page 49) and ECCE course is now made mandatory for all teachers for Age group 3 to 9 Years.
